(If you are a current ADN student, the degree and licensure must be complete before acceptance into the program).		
4.	<input type="checkbox"/>	Hold a current, unencumbered RN license from the state of Texas or enhanced compact license. (If you are a current ADN student, the degree and licensure must be complete before acceptance into the program).
