


Your Guide to

Connecting with Ease at Newark Liberty International Airport

EWR Airport Overview



Flights between Presque Isle and Newark typically depart and arrive from Terminal A, Concourse A2, or Terminal C, Concourse C3.

United mainline flights operate to and from Terminal C, while flights to other United Express destinations will typically operate to and from Terminal A.

When you land at Newark check the United monitors, which list flights alphabetically by destination, for the gate number of your connecting flight. There could be more than one flight to your connecting city, so be sure to cross-reference the flight number on your boarding pass.

You do not need to re-clear security to travel between Terminal A and Terminal C. United operates a frequent shuttle between the terminals.

In Terminal A, you can catch the shuttle near Gate A28 – just follow the signs and go down one level to the ground-level shuttle boarding area.

In Terminal C, you can catch the shuttle near Gate C71 – again, follow the signs and go down one level to the ground-level shuttle boarding area.

The shuttle also makes stops in Terminal B, at Concourses B1 and B3, for international connections to Star Alliance partner flights. Some United international flights also arrive at Terminal B.

Use the maps on this guide to locate the concourse where your gate is located. All gates numbers are preceded by the terminal letter – A, B, or C.
