

### CAT/LYNX FACTS

For Fiscal Year Ended June 30, 2016

- Transported 153,889 riders on all routes and services
- Operated a total of 24,205 service hours
- Traveled a total of 416,116 service miles
- Broken down by Service
  - LYNX
    - Operated a total of 6,478 Service Hours
    - Traveled a total of 174,447 Service Miles
    - Carried a total of 60,056 Riders
  - CAT Fixed Route
    - Operated a total of 10,065 Service Hours
    - Traveled a total of 149,884 Service Miles
    - Carried a total of 77,969 Riders
  - CAT Paratransit/ADA
    - Operated a total of 7,662 Service Hours
    - Traveled a total of 91,825 Service Miles
    - Carried a total of 15,864 Riders


## Annual Passenger Totals from 2012

# Key Findings From Transit Survey Done August 2016 By TransitPlus

#### Value of CAT and LYNX

- 89% strongly agree that CAT and LYNX are important community services.
- 81% are within walking distance of a bus stop.
- 72% strongly agree the buses are safe and dependable.
- 72% strongly agree that with bus services, residents can live and work without owning a car or owning fewer cars.
- 73% of LYNX riders are going to/from work while only 18% of CAT riders use the bus for work travel.
- Roughly 41% of CAT riders do not have a driver license.
- CAT bus stops are placed at 5 primary senior communities and the Verde Valley Senior Center

- Contracted Service with Verde Valley Caregivers Coalition provides over 200 rides a month to seniors and others with disabilities throughout the Verde Valley to medical and other appointments
